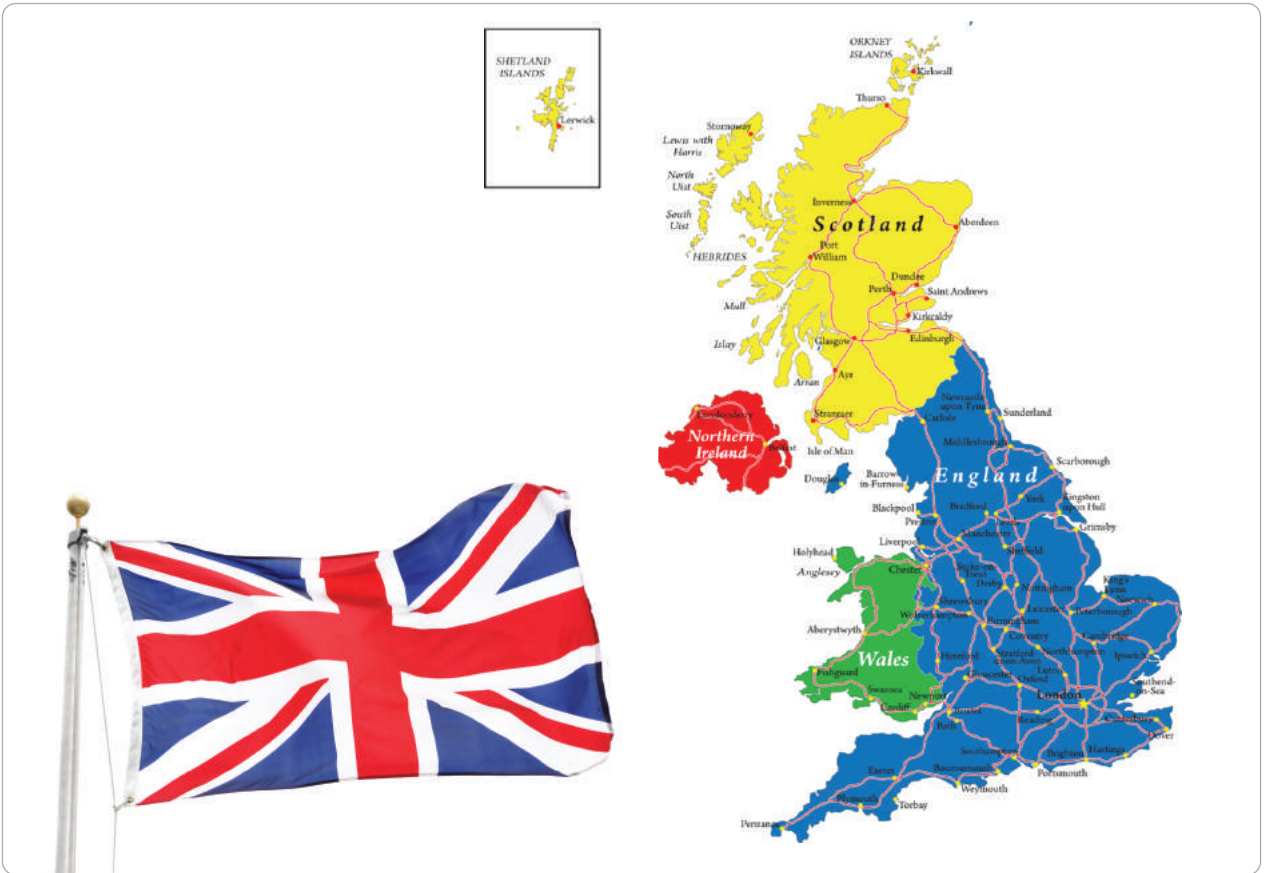
Hi!

England has always had lots of Kings and Queens.

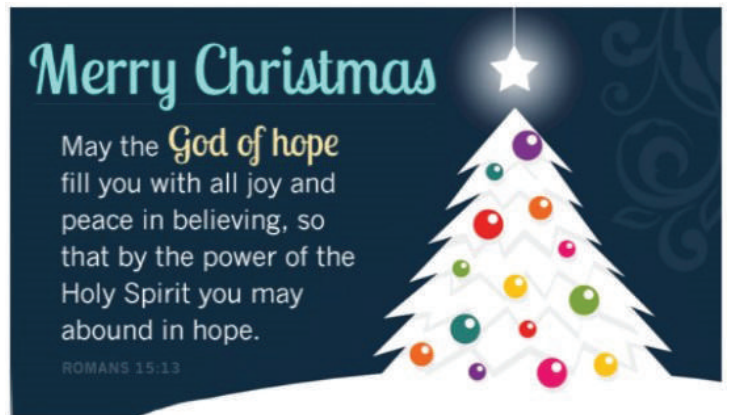
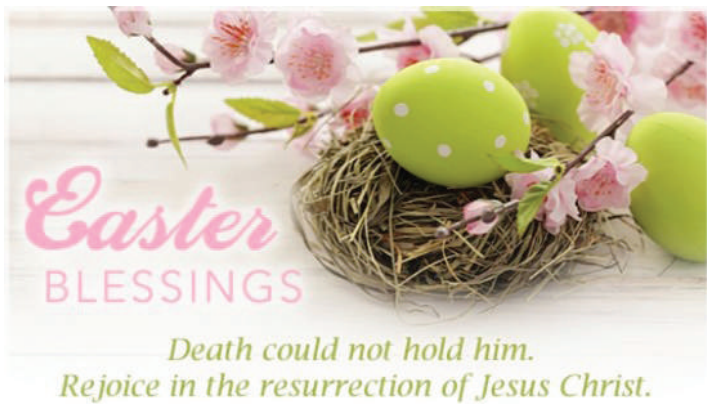
One very famous King was Henry the Eighth.
